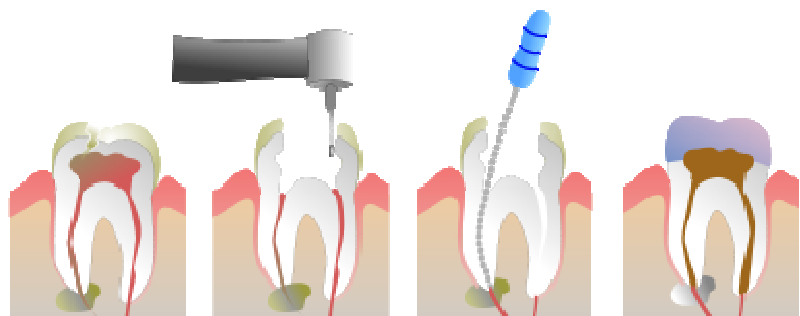
- Do small tooth-sized circles.

Video Project 3: Endodontic Therapy



- ☑ Endodontic therapy is a sequence of treatment for the pulp of a tooth whose end result is the elimination of infection and protection of the decontaminated tooth from future microbial invasion. Although this set of procedures is commonly referred to as a root canal, this term is imprecise...

- ☑ **unbearable** /ʌn'beə.rə.bl/ adjective
too painful or unpleasant for you to continue to experience:
All I remember of childbirth was the unbearable pain and the relief when it was all over.
The heat was unbearable.

- ☑ natural
≠ artificial, synthetic /sm'θet.ɪk/

- ☑ **hollow** /'hɒl.əʊ/ adjective
having a hole or empty space inside:
a hollow tube

hollow /'hɒl.əʊ/ noun [C]
a hole or empty space in something, or a low area in a surface:
The dog found a hollow in the ground to hide in from the wind.

- ☑ You access something.
