  - Mont Blanc is France's highest mountain with a height of 3600 metres.
  - In our opinion, Jean-Jacques Goldman is France's second best singer.
  
- ☑ Wales is not an independent nation. In 1292 the English king Edward the First invaded Wales and built 14 huge castles to control the Welsh people.
  - Elizabeth the Second
  - Richard the Lionheart
  - William the Conqueror
  
- ☑ His son, Edward, became the first Prince of Wales. Since then, all the kings and queens of England have given their eldest son the title Prince of Wales. I'm sure you know who the latest one is...
